

Myths/Legend

A Myth is a story, usually a historical one, explaining an event or mystery. A Myth is generally not true.

A Legend is story, usually about a historical figure, explaining an event. Some aspects of a Legend can be true.

Objective: Create your own myth or legend.

What you story must have:

- Characters (people or even animals)
- Setting (place, time)
- Plot/conflict (what is happening in the story)
- Resolution to story (ending)

Your story must be 1 or 2 pages long, double spaced.
